Adults seem to have a gut committment to addition, improvement, and renovation. It is interesting that ; these youngsters feel so strongly to the contrary, where Star is concerned. Are they just resisting adult views or does their less conditioned intuition perceive an important point?

At the time I was mulling over the kids attidude, we happened to get a letter from Joe Bram, age sixty-three, another dedicated Shoaler, in which he mentioned proposed improvements at the island, concluding with the sentence, "It's all very exciting as long as they don't make the Oceanic and the rest too comfortable." Sounds as if he were trying to be broad minded but basically feels the way the young people do.
